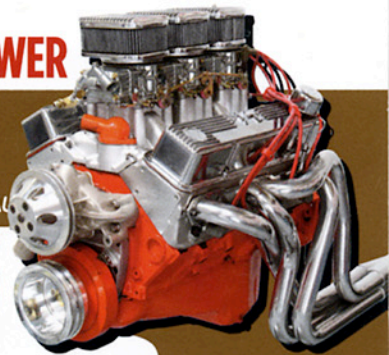

DICK & SUE FREUND | FOND DU LAC, WI | 1955 CHEVY SEDAN

They love Tri-Five Chevys at Back To The 50's. Dick and Sue Freund were in St. Paul with this beautiful '55 two-door traditional custom. Shaved doors, side pipes, and some cool red flames over gold paint are the first thing to grab your attention. The lowered Chevy hugs the ground and rolls on 15-inch steel chrome wheels with Coker wide whites. The custom interior is highlighted by white tuck 'n' roll on the bench seat and a '59 Impala steering wheel on a tilt column—plus some period-style pinstriping. The Chevy 350 is dressed up with a Cadillac air cleaner and more subtle 'striping.

The Freund family had more than one '55 Chevy at this event. This two-door sedan is owned by Mike and Angel, the parents of Dick Freund, who were also Top 100 winners this weekend. Wearing silver scallops over jade green paint and a fully louvered hood, this '55 is also a great example of classic custom style. Wide whites, chrome steelies, pipes, and a tube grille add to the appeal. The engine is a Chevy 283 with six Deuces, backed up by a TH350 transmission. The traditional white interior has additional gauges mounted below the dash and a tall shifter.
